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About Us

Stetson Court Living is a staff-operated residential facility for ambulatory or non-ambulatory elderly residents ages 60 and above, and for those residents that show progressive decline in cognitive function beyond what might be expected from normal aging and that may require services and oversight due to conditions such as dementia. We offer 24 hour care and supervision (7) days a week. This home is licensed as a Community Care Facility for six (6) residents. Our program strives to ensure that the individuals in our home realize their individualized potential to live lives that are integrated, productive, and normal to the extent and this will be to each individual's interest and capacity.

Stetson Court Living is a home designed to care for those who do not wish or are unable to live alone but who need:

- A home-like atmosphere in which to reside.
- To do as much as they can by themselves, even though they may have challenges in completing activities of daily living.
- To have assistance when they are unable to manage independently.

- To have something to do that has interest and meaning to them like church, lodge, and clubs.
- To keep in touch with relatives and friends.

Our program is suited for individuals who require assistance with such things like, mobility, transportation, and daily living assistance (cooking and cleaning) as well as assistance in administration of medication. We feel that many individuals thrive socially when staff is shouldering the burdens and chores that they can't take care of any more.

Stetson Court Living offers services to individuals who are at least 60 years old and who would benefit from Non-medical Care and Supervision. We offer 24-hour care and supervision seven (7) days a week. From the hours of 10pm to 6am staff members are on call for emergencies. Night supervision will be provided in our facility (shall have one night staff person awake and on duty) if any resident with dementia is determined through a pre-admission appraisal, reappraisal or observation to require awoken night staff supervision.



Stetson Court Living is a Quality minded service provider that makes our home different than most facilities that provide these services and that we ensure that the needs are met in a small home-like community setting with only (6) residents in the home. We find that many individuals are not comfortable in large settings where there is too much noise, too many staff and not enough care.

Stetson Court Living is committed to provide a safe environment in a non-institutional setting, which is able to meet the needs of individuals in a personal way. We strive -to provide the least amount of intrusion on individual's daily routine in order to assist but at the same time staff socialized with people living in our home to increase enjoyment as well as increasing rapport.



Stetson Court Living is a community based care home and we are dedicated to increasing community integration and social interactions. Our staff is always checking for available appropriate community based activities.

Transportation Policy

The facility arranges for or provides residents with local transportation other than that which is required for attendance at day programs.

Residents requiring transportation for medical and dental appointments, social events, etc. Where public transportation is not a feasible option, are provided with transportation by the facility staff or administrator, or as arranged by the facility (e.g. taxi or other public transportation). There may be unusual circumstances under which a resident must travel great distances (e.g. for special medical consultation), in such cases the facility administrator may work with the resident representative to arrange transportation.

Activities may include shopping, group and individual outings and community events. In addition to our basic services, additional services are available for an additional charge.
